CHIC's 4 year Compliance Auditing Framework provides Compliance Audit Services and can be accessed by any of CHIC's members.

The framework seeks to provide national coverage across the United Kingdom. Framework suppliers have selected those regions where they are able to provide a service.

The framework supports CHIC's Members to access a range of Internal Policy Compliance and Site Portfolio Audits along with Site Contractor Assurance Audits. The audit process is an integral part of regulatory management to ensure that works are completed to a defined scope/specification of works in line with the member's requirements, whilst complying with legislative and company policy requirements.





THE BREAKDOWN

The framework is split into eight different Lots as below:

1 Asbestos Management Auditing

Suppliers will conduct independent audits on behalf of the member and/or the removal contractor. The audits will assess the key legal requirements and site conditions to ensure that working procedures are being implemented correctly and in line with current regulations and the highest industry standards.

2 Commercial Gas Auditing

The suppliers shall undertake control audits of members' commercial gas management and safety policies, procedures, documentation training/competency and record keeping.

3 Domestic Gas Auditing

This service audits the performance of third-party contractors in tenanted property against laid down requirements including the Gas Safety (Installation and Use) Regulations and the member's tender document.

4 Electrical Safety Auditing

The audit the effective and compliant delivery of integrated facilities management services within all accessible areas of a range of residential buildings (including High Rise High Risk) in conformance to security protocols.

5 Fire Safety Auditing

The audit will be developed in collaboration with fire safety experts and recognition of relevant standards, focus on key aspects of managing fire safety within the workplace and offers a structured route toward continual improvement and best practice status.

6 Lifting Equipment Auditing

Policy Compliance Audits will assess a member's duty under The Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations (LOLER) and The Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations (PUWER) and ensure procedures and policies are in place, with a goal of formulating and providing a Compliance Report.

7 Mechanical and Electrical Auditing

The audit will deliver internal requirements in an integrated facilities management (Hard & Soft) environment providing and applying lead knowledge of mechanical, electrical and building services engineering.

8 Water Hygiene Auditing

The audit will, through measuring performance, ensure water safety has been implemented and will assess how well it is performing at controlling risks, which may identify vulnerabilities within a water safety plan.

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
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
