



The establishment of Framework is the establishment of a public contract therefore the following is permitted:

Call-off Award Mechanism	Allowed
Without Further Competition	
Through Further Competition	



Call Offs Under Frameworks



Objective Mechanism for supplier selection A contract can be awarded under a framework without further competition where;

- a. only one supplier is party to the framework, or
- b. if the framework sets out:
 - i. the core terms of the public contract, and
 - ii. an objective mechanism for supplier selection.

Section 12 Covered procurement: Objectives

When conducting Call-off of any type the Authority has the duty to consider:

Sharing Delivering Maximising Acting delivering value for maximising public sharing information acting, and being seen benefit; for the purpose of to act, with integrity money; allowing suppliers and others to understand the authority's procurement policies and decisions;

Section 12 Covered procurement: Objectives



Treat suppliers the same unless a difference between the suppliers justifies different treatment



Ensure not to put a supplier at an unfair advantage or disadvantage



Have regard to and where possible remove barriers to SME's

Section 12 Covered procurement: Objectives

Qualification Systems

The establishment of Dynamic Market is **not** an establishment of a public contract therefore only the following is permitted:

No requirement to publish notices for contracts under threshold



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








Most Economically Advantageous Tender (MEAT)



Call-Off Terms

When calling off, whether through call off competition the document must adhere to the information flowed down by the Framework or Dynamic Market, including the following:

- a description of goods, services or works to be provided which must broadly align with the framework or DM scope;
- the price payable, or should follow the mechanism for determining the price payable as flowed down.





Section 54 Time Limits for Call-off;

Minimum Tender Periods

Frameworks

Dynamic Markets

10 Working Days







Section 54 Time Limits for Calloff;

- a) the nature and complexity of the contract being awarded.
- the need for site visits, physical inspections and other practical steps;
- c) the need for sub-contracting;
- d) the nature and complexity of any modification of the tender notice or any associated tender documents;
- e) the importance of avoiding unnecessary delay.




